TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(Please retain this portion)

- The tournament will be conducted under the rules and regulations of NZT.
- Player behaviour: NZT Code of Conduct will apply. Players should refer to the tournament noticeboards for details. Competitors are to umpire own matches as per NZT Code of conduct for self-umpiring. Competitors must be prepared to umpire when called upon.
- Through to the finals matches will be the first to nine games, with the twelve point tie-breaker played at eight all. Final will be the best of three tie-breaker sets.
- Play will be continuous throughout the day. No player shall absent themselves from the grounds during the hours of play without first obtaining permission of the Contoller.
- Every competitor **MUST** be prepared to play immediately when called upon. Failure to do so will result in the player being scratched from the event.
- Players must report:

12's & 16's	Report 10am Friday
	Report 8am Saturday/ Sunday
10's & 14's	Report 2pm Friday
	Report 8am Saturday/ Sunday
18's	Report 1pm Saturday - Play till late
	Report 10am Sunday
- Plate events for first round singles losers only, and doubles matches if time is available. Additional plate if time and numbers permit.
- Canned Slazenger balls will be provided, used balls for plate matches.
- Maximum warm-up period of three minutes allowed.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, and the right to change events as thought necessary.
- Under special circumstances the organisers will accept payment on the day, provided it is made before the commencement of the tournament.
- Appropriate tennis clothing to be worn for all matches.
- Players may enter in only one age group. Any extra entry is by the organisers request.
- The age groups are: eligible until 1st day of month of 19th birthday (18's)

1st day of month of 17th birthday (16's)
1st day of month of 15th birthday (14's)
1st day of month of 13th birthday (12's)
1st day of month of 11th birthday (10's)
- No person other than the match players, umpires and the referee may be on the courts during play. It is against the rules of Tennis for a player to receive coaching in any form from spectators. Spectators may encourage players but must avoid giving them advice.
- All competitors are to take total responsibility for their own equipment.
